## RULES TINSLEY PARK GOLF CLUB

### LOCAL RULES

#### A ball is out of bounds when it is:

- Over any boundary fence / perimeter fence / or line of white markers
- On or over the path to the left of the 1st tee or behind the 1st teeing area
- Beyond the line of white markers to the rear of the 2nd green.
- To the right of the line of white posts found running alongside the buggy path to the right of the 3rd fairway and between the 3rd and 4th fairways (only applies when playing the 3rd)
- Over the fence to the left of the 3rd fairway and to the left and rear of the 3rd green.
- On any part of the practice area to the left of the 7th fairway
- To the right of the line of white markers between the 10th and 11th fairways (only applies when playing the 10th)
- On any part of the practice area to the left of the 16th fairway
- Beyond the line of white markers to the left of the 17th fairway and to the left and rear of the 17th green
- Over the fence to the right of the 18th fairway and green
- On or over the path or on the bowling green to the rear of the 18th green

### OTHER RULES

#### There is a free drop

#### (no nearer the hole) from:

- Any 'encased or staked' trees or saplings if they interfere with the stance or playing of the ball down a pre-nominated line of play
- Any lie that falls within one club length of a winter tee
- Any lie that falls on a green or temporary green, other than the one in play
- The drainage hollows that cross the 16th and 18th fairways. (A 'free drop' is only applicable when the ball lies in a drainage hollow on the fairway)
- The sleepers that form the paths that cross the 'open' drainage on the 5th and 16th holes
- Any artificial path or surface throughout the course
- The paths that run across the 8th fairway
- In the water tank compound or within one club length of the compound fence, between the 3rd and 4th fairways. (You must be able to identify to your marker that the ball is yours)
- Any water sprinklers that interfere with your swing or stance
- Any area clearly marked as ground under repair

#### In winter there is also a free drop (no nearer the hole) from:

- Any lie on a grass tee that has been roped off
- Any plugged lie, anywhere on the course, with the exception of being in a hazard

#### Please note:

- You may remove stones from bunkers
- It is common etiquette to replace all divots, smooth out bunkers and repair pitch marks on greens
- A free drop is one club length from the nearest point of maximum relief
- A penalty drop is two club lengths from where the ball lies
- Any complaints should be put in writing and sent to the Club Secretary
